A total of 33 European countries will be organising events and activities for young people around the themes of participation, inclusion and employment at the end of this month and beginning of May.

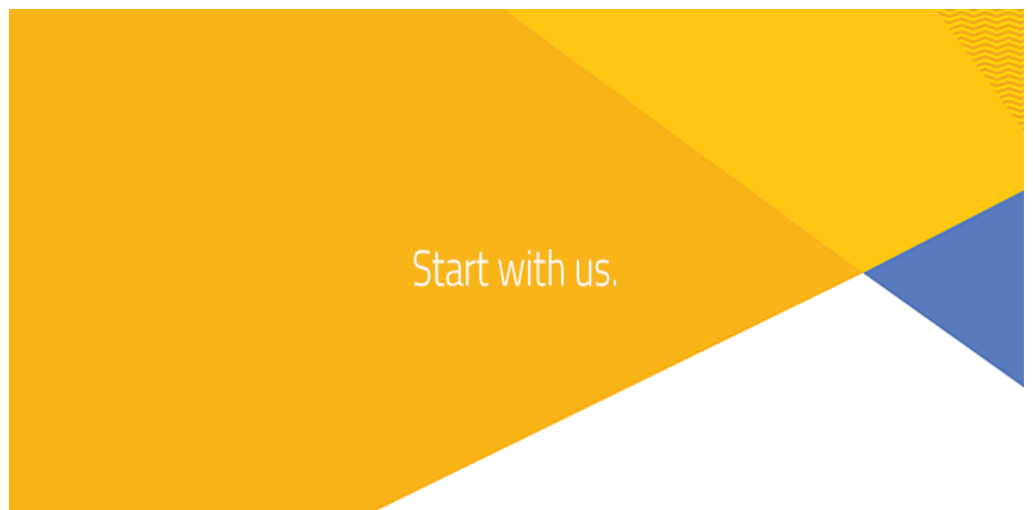
Malta will be one of the 33 countries that will host a number of activities aimed at reaching and involving youths.
